Course Description:

This two-day course focuses on the mechanics of marksmanship at speed with a carbine and pistol as well as transitioning between weapons systems. This course is not about tactics, although tactical application of all techniques taught will be discussed, but instead is about skill with the firearm, but instead is about skill with firearms. pouches capable of retaining weapon and magazines during strenuous movement. Serviceable carbine, if pistol
caliber then 9mm or larger, if rifle caliber 5.56 or larger. Minimum 3 carbine magazines, belt and at least one
carbine magazine pouch capable of retaining magazines during strenuous movement, and a secure sling.
Minimum 500 rounds each of pistol and carbine ammunition although more is recommended. Eye/ear protection for
range. No Serpa holsters or soft nylon/leather holsters permitted in class.
