Course Description: RAPID ENGAGEMENT TACTICS UTILIZING THE DESIGNATED MARKSMAN RIFLE

The purpose of this course is to better prepare Officers in quick deployment of carbines or designated marksman rifles to put accurate fire on targets from CQB distances to 300 yards. Both speed and accuracy will be stressed. Skills taught are a combination of professional long range competitive shooting and established SWAT tactics.

This course will allow law enforcement officers to access techniques for deploying a patrol carbine or designated marksman rifle as rapidly and accurately as possible under stress. Students will become thoroughly familiar with the fundamentals of marksmanship and will progress to realistic dynamic shooting scenarios that might be encountered. Students will cover topics that include weapon system and limitations, range estimation, dope and wind calculations for mid-range engagements and practical shooting scenarios and tactics from CQB distances to 300 yards. First round impacts and round accountability will be stressed throughout the course.

Instructor bio: Joe Privitt:

Joe is a Police Officer with a career of over 33 years with 27 years experience as a SWAT Team member, 25 years on the assault team,14 years as Team Leader and 2 Years experience as a member of the sniper unit. Joe has years of involvement in all aspects of SWAT operations including planning, execution and teaching of high risk warrants, deliberate searches, barricades, vehicle takedowns, buy busts, hostage rescue, bus assaults, etc. Joe is also a TCOLE instructor with extensive training experience for TTPOA.

Instructor bio: Daniel Jarecke:

Daniel Jarecke is a professional long range shooter that has been competing professionally since 2017. He has 4 national championship event wins and 10 podium (top 3) finishes, and more than 15 state regional wins. He is the sport's only consecutive 2-time winner of the Best in Texas national AG Cup match. Daniel has trained numerous law enforcement snipers for TTPOA and other agencies such as Dallas and Garland SWAT as well as civilian long range competitive shooters. He has developed strategies for target engagement that are based on hit percentages and probabilities that have helped him gain a tactical advantage over his competition.

Required Equipment:

Semi automatic DMR or bolt action rifle with LPVO or elevation and windage adjustable optic capable of 2 MOA accuracy, duty pistol, 300 rounds of rifle ammunition, 100 rounds of pistol ammunition and appropriate callout gear including plates. Bring water and lunch for both days.

Current or retired LEO. Must have completed LEO or other acceptable carbine course (email to discuss acceptable courses). Students must be familiar with weapons platform and arrive at class with weapons zeroed and ready to shoot.
